Drumbow Contracts Limited (in Administration) (“the Company”)

I refer to the Joint Administrators’ progress report on the Administration of the Company for the period 6 August 2012 to 8 January 2013 under Rule 2.44 of the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986.

I would like to inform you that the Joint Administrators intend to make an application to the Court of Session for an order pursuant to Paragraph 76 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 for an extension of the period of the Administration.

The Administrators intend to request an extension for a 12 month period until 5 February 2014. This extension is requested to enable the Administrators’ time to complete various outstanding case matters, including collecting outstanding book debts from completed and ongoing contracts.
