This payment represents an improved milk price for both the initial two week period and subsequent month and, where applicable, an additional payment dependant on the classification of the milk supplied.


By successfully concluding milk swaps, haulage final accounts and collection of milk supply debtors the Receivers have managed to improve the milk price and despite there still being some provisions for debtor collections and final accounts, the Bank has agreed to take the risk of those provisions to allow the final milk cheques to be issued.

A statement showing the litrage supplied and the improved milk price used to calculate your payment is enclosed.
