Partnership Action for Continuing Employment (PACE) is the Scottish Government's initiative to support people facing redundancy.

PACE aims to minimise the time people affected by redundancy are out of work.

All services delivered through PACE are confidential, free of charge and include helping you to:

- understand the redundancy process, as well as your rights and entitlements
- check what benefits you may be entitled to and review your tax calculations
- effectively look for jobs
- write CVs, application forms and cover letters and prepare for interviews
- identify learning and funding opportunities, including the [National Transition Training Fund](#)
- start up a business
- make the most of your money
- access free and impartial advice regarding workplace and personal pensions.
- cope with redundancy-related stress
