Who should attend?

This course is designed for those requiring a practical guide to the full PPP/PFI process applied to the Social Housing. It aims to build on a basic knowledge of the concepts of PPP/PFI.

Course Summary

This practical "how to" course is structured around the 14 stage PPP/PFI procurement process applied to a social housing context and concentrates on the areas that often cause the practitioner difficulty in practice. The course will be highly interactive with housing specific exercises and case studies designed to highlight the key learning points of the sessions and focus on the information available in terms of guidance and examples. Delegates receive a "Toolkit" containing checklists, example documentation and housing guidance materials which are used extensively throughout the course, and provide future reference when back at the workplace.

Objectives for the course are to:

- Explain the steps in the procurement process
- Focus on what can be done to make the process more efficient and effective
- Consider the practical effects of the principles of PPP/PFI with the housing – risk, payment, value for money, affordability, as well as the specific issues facing PPP/PFI in the sector.
