

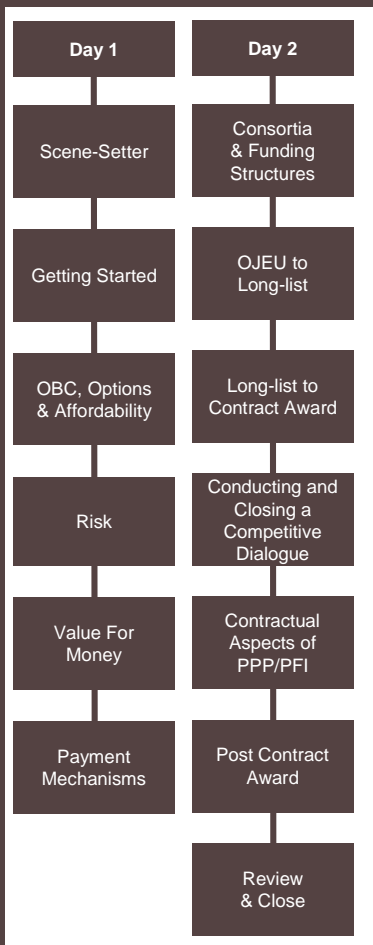

#### Course Summary

This practical "how to" course is structured around a 14 stage PPP/PFI procurement process and concentrates on the areas that often cause the practitioner difficulty in practice.
