### In our 2019 CEO survey, Slovak CEOs state that:

**79%** are worried about the availability of key skills.

**70%** are somewhat or extremely concerned about **changing** workforce demographics.

**51%** are expecting to increase headcount over the next 12 months.

## According to our 2019 CEO Survey, CEOs say the biggest threats to their business relate to human resources:

93% consider the quality of secondary and university education as a big threat to a successful business.

**72%** of Slovak CEOs say that the level of mathematical skills of graduates is insufficient for their needs.

### However, we also see that:

65% of Slovak CEOs believe that a low level of language skills is creating a business risk for their companies.

94% of Slovak CEOs responded that employee-related data is criticial for them, however, only a minority of surveyed companies collect this data on a consistent basis.
