# Award eligibility

To enter, your organisation must be a UK based social enterprise that meets the [Social Enterprise UK criteria](#). You must also submit an impact report as part of the application in order to be considered. Social enterprise will be defined using the following criteria:

## You should:

- Have a clear social and/or environmental mission set out in your governing documents
- Generate the majority of your income through trade
- Reinvest the majority of your profits
- Be autonomous of state
- Be majority controlled in the interests of the social mission
- Be accountable and transparent



# Application and judging process

**Applications open: Wednesday 15th May 2019 at 9:00am**

**Application closing date: Thursday 13th June 2019 at 5:00pm**

- Up to two documents can be uploaded to the application form as supporting evidence of impact. Please note that any applications received without an impact report will not be considered
- Any applications received after 5:00pm on Thursday 13th June 2019 will not be considered. PwC is not responsible for applications which are lost, damaged or late due to computer, network or telecommunications failure
- Applications will be reviewed initially by representatives from the School for Social Entrepreneurs and PwC, who will draw up a shortlist of ten applications
- The ten shortlisted entrants will then be reviewed by a panel of experts from PwC, Social Enterprise UK, School for Social Entrepreneurs and social enterprises to identify three finalists
- The three finalists are then presented to our Building Public Trust Awards panel of judges who will choose an overall winner

**You may be contacted with questions should any clarification be needed during consideration of your application. The judges' decision about eligibility, shortlisting and selection, including the methodology used to assess applicants, validity of any claims and data submitted, is final and correspondence will not be entered into**

# Judging criteria

It is important that you upload an impact report as part of your application. Our expert judges will be using the following criteria when reviewing your submission:

Demonstrates social impact in line with the organisation's social mission and objectives

Includes good quantitative and qualitative evidence

Demonstrates thorough measurement, reporting, evaluation and communication processes

Includes detail of how the award will be used to increase the impact of the social enterprise

# Winner announcements and celebration event

- The shortlisted applicants will be announced in our Building Public Trust Awards communications and the PwC Social Entrepreneurs Club newsletter in autumn 2019
- Should your organisation be shortlisted, we will use any image and logo that you submit with your application form in our awards brochure, on our website and in other relevant communications
- All shortlisted applicants are requested to attend an awards ceremony on **Thursday 3rd October 2019** in London where the winners will be announced. At that time, we would request permission to photograph the winners and promote them and their award through various channels. Submitting an application will be considered permission for us to promote your organisation and award, should you be successful.
