All UK employers have a duty to prevent illegal working, and as such are required to undertake document checks and keep records to evidence that the checks have been carried out correctly. These are currently undertaken virtually, as we continue to work from home wherever possible.

The concession introduced by UK Visas and Immigration during the COVID pandemic has meant that employers can carry out checks remotely to remain compliant, but full checks will need to be completed within 8 weeks of restrictions being lifted – we expect this to be in the course of 2021.
